Good Evening everyone! I take immense pride and pleasure to stand before you to present the Annual Report of our school. Our School is started its journey in 1996 with just 7 students to impart value and skills based education to the students. Under the able guidance of our Honourable Correspondent Dr. Krishna Chandji Chordia. Today the school has taken roots and has grown into a full-fledged Senior Secondary School with the strength of around 4000 students, 200 teaching faculties and 15 non – teaching faculties. Our Mission is to ensure that the each child enjoys and connects to the present global visions.

INFRASTRUCTURE:

Our School has a vast lush and green campus with a big play ground. It is functioning well with the support of HOD's of various departments. We have huge well – stocked Library for the teachers and students to read and refer. The well - equipped Physics Lab, Chemistry Lab, Biology Lab, Computer Science Lab, Math Lab and Robotics Lab makes teaching interesting and enjoyable. The Arihanth Hall and the Ahimsa Hall with Smart Board Facility supports digital education, workshops and faculty meetings. Our KG Block stands independent with the modern amenities to help the tiny tots learn at ease. An elevator has been installed to facilitate the teaching faculties. The entire campus is under the surveillance of CCTV in order to ensure tight security. We have a Terrace garden where Organic Farming is done for a healthy living.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS:

The commandable success or achievement would have been a mere dream but for the determined, committed, dedicated and hard working efforts of the Management, staff and co-operative parents.

Our students of Class X came with remarkable performance in the AISSE (2017-18). 33 students scored a perfect 10 Point Grade and emerged as Toppers,

followed by 8 students with 9.8/10, 13 students with 9.6/10 and many students scored 9.4/10.

In AISSCE (2017-18) Class XII Board Exams, R.YOGALAKSHMI was the school Topper with 455/500. She was also the subject topper in English, Accountancy, Economics, Business Studies and Computer Science. D. PRIYANKA came second with 421/500 followed by S. SAKTHI UMA with the score of 419/500.

Our students of Class X came with remarkable performance in the AISSE (2018-19). T. VALLI was the Topper scoring 441/500 followed by J. KAMALINI with 432/500 and V. SRIJA & O. SUSHMA scored 426/500 and stood third. I proudly state that many students scored above 400.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY:

Various programs are conducted during the General Assembly. Students are given opportunities to showcase their talents in Debates, Speeches, Skits etc., which helps in shaping their future.

CO - CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:
